The final round will take place at the Zurich Insurance Global Risk Management Summit where the team will be presenting their risk mitigation and strategy proposal to 100 top global business executives. The summit will take place from 28-30 September at the iconic Intercontinental Carlton Hotel, Cannes in France. This year's theme is "Is disruption the new normal?"

The Zurich Enterprise Challenge has three phases, run by the Zurich Insurance Group and Project Firefly. This competition aims to identity the very best talent among the group of young people who want to start a career
